- All requests for aid from the Bishops' Lenten Appeal Fund must be approved and signed by the Diocesan Lenten Appeal Director, AND the Bishop/Administrator of the Diocese concerned, or by the Chairperson of the relative SACBC Department or Office for inter-departmental requests.
- 2. THIS APPLICATION must reach the Lenten Appeal Director of your diocese by 01 April 2016 and must reach the National Office by 29 April 2016.
- 3. The Diocesan Director will give comments and then present it to the Diocesan Bishop/Administrator for approval and signature. It will then be forwarded to the SACBC Lenten Appeal Administration Office

- 4. An application form should be used for one project only. If applying for help for different projects please use separate application forms indicating you priorities, as it may not be possible to fund all of them.
- 5. For help with HIV/AIDS ministry, please apply to the relevant Office of the SACBC
- 6. If you receive a grant, you will be required to SEND a report of how the money has been spent by 30 April next year. The report is to be sent to the National Director.
- 7. DIOCESAN DIRECTORS of the Lenten Appeal are asked to examine all requests for aid before forwarding them to the National Office. The opinion of the Diocesan Director is especially valuable when making a decision as to whether and how much help should be given.
- 8. Lenten Appeal grants are *ad hoc* donations. The Lenten Appeal fund *does not* commit itself to regular annual payments.
